OPERATION: DESIGN MISSION PATCH

Who: All Avicenna Academy Family Members (students, teachers, parents, friends, etc...)

What: Design a Mission Patch for our Participation in the Student Spaceflight Experiments Program. The winning patch design will be flown with our experiment on the last ever flight of the Space Shuttle Atlantis!

When: All submissions are due by 3:30pm on Monday, May 9, 2011. Winning entry will be announced on Friday, May 13th and displayed on our SSEP blog and Avicenna Academy's website.

Where: All submissions must be turned in to the main office at Avicenna Academy

Requirements:

1. The emblem should be a 4-inch x 4-inch piece of paper, and its design should reflect pride in your community, and your participation in the SSEP.
2. Design must include the SSEP's community acronym (AASCC) AND the school's name, somewhere on the patch.
3. There is no restriction on the type of paper or the inks to be used.
4. The emblem can be black & white or full color.
5. The emblem can only be composed of a single sheet of 4-inch x 4-inch paper and the ink on the paper.
6. The emblem cannot include multiple layers of paper glued or taped on top of one another.
7. Put the designer's name on the back of the submission, being careful not to let the ink bleed through the front.

*On return from space, your Mission Patch will be returned to you for your community to display. It will be a testament to the participation by your students, teachers, and community in the Student Spaceflight Experiments Program, and recognition that your community was part of America's Space Shuttle Program at this historic moment.

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
