Since 2004, Avicenna Academy, established on a foundation of faith, character, and scholarship, has been educating its students as the next generation of American Muslim scholars.

The goal of Avicenna is to instruct young students in both standard and religious subjects based on the Qur'an and classical



Islamic studies. At Avicenna Academy, children can learn not only standard curriculum but also Islamic studies and the Arabic language. They pray daily and

learn religious stories from the Qur'an. In a spirit of multiculturalism, Avicenna employs teachers who are both Christian and Muslim.



The academy started with a total of 22 students. Since then, enrollment has more than doubled, reaching 53 students in the 2007-08 school

year. Enrollment is open to children of all faiths and backgrounds with classes from preschool to elementary and growing toward middle school.

The History of Avicenna

Avicenna was an eleventh century Persian philosopher who spent his life as a physician and scholar at many Islamic courts. Given the title *al-Sheikh al-Rais* by his students, it translates to *Leader Among the Wise Men*. Though nearly a thousand years have passed, the name *Avicenna* is still revered in the East. One of the wisest of physicians, he is also known as the *Prince of Physicians* for his famous medical text *al-Qanun* or *Canon*.
